



KC NTMA Ivan and Holder Memorial Scholarship

Purpose

The KC NTMA Ivan and Holder Memorial Scholarship is an annual tuition scholarship created by the Kansas City National Tooling and Machining Association in support of students advancing their education and pursuing careers in manufacturing. Successful scholarship applicants will receive a minimum award of \$500.00. It is the intent of the Association to award on average up to three (3) scholarships annually. Awards will be made for the spring and fall semesters.

Selection

The KC NTMA Board of Directors shall serve as the selection committee, and shall make the final selection of the scholarship recipient from a list of those students making application under criteria outlined in the Eligibility Requirements.

Eligibility Requirements

All Applicants Must:

- Be at least 18 years at time of class start and attending the Metropolitan Community College – Business and Technology Campus and/or the Kansas City Kansas Community College
- Be a member of a high school senior class and is planning to attend an accredited educational facility as a full-time student; or be a high school graduate enrolled to continue his or her education in a manufacturing industry related discipline. For purposes of this scholarship, full-time student is defined as a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours per semester.
- Submit scholarship application and supporting documentation by July 1st (Fall Semester) and December 1st (Spring Semester) of applicable year.
- Must be nominated by an NTMA Member Company in Good Standing or an accredited educational partner.

Provide a written essay stating career goals, and why they should receive the Scholarship (500 words or less).

- Provide a written resume describing interests, classes, and any work-related activities voluntary or paid.
- Provide one (1) letter of recommendation from a Business professional (employer, teachers, clergy etc.) who are aware of their desire to pursue a career in manufacturing.



Application

Applicants are requested to read carefully all of the above conditions of this program and submit a fully executed Application by July 1st (Fall Semester) or December 1st (Spring Semester) of applicable year. Awards will be made for the fall and spring semesters.

Award

The KC NTMA Ivan and Holder Memorial Scholarship Fund will be paid upon proof of acceptance into appropriate education facility as defined above.
